

## Centro Multimodal Industrial y de Servicios and Colon International Airport

Colon, Republic of Panama

The Centro Multimodal Industrial y de Servicios (CEMIS), along with the Colon International Airport, was a projected development for the multimodal expansion of the Colon Free Trade Zone.

McKinney Internacional provided master planning services for CEMIS' 120 hectare site. The primary parcel is approximately 80 hectares lying directly east of the airport with an additional 40 hectare in a series of parcels located to the west. The land bays west of the airport are adjacent to the Manzanillo Spur of the Panama Canal Railway and also provide direct access to the ports.

In addition to master planning, McKinney provided surveying, geotechnical investigation, engineering—including mass grading, erosion / sediment control, primary stormwater system and creek relocation and improvement design for the combined industrial and airport area (240 hectares), and general consulting.
